Public Holidays in Bermuda

The following is a list of public holidays for the years 2009, 2010 and 2011. Note that Government Offices are closed on every public holiday, Saturday and Sunday throughout the year, but are otherwise open for business each week from Monday through Friday, 8:45 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Public holidays that fall on a Sunday are normally observed the following day.

Note for the year 2009

As Bermuda Day, 24th May 2009, falls on a Sunday, by virtue of the Public Holidays Act 1947 Monday, 25th May will be kept as a public holiday according to the Schedule to the Act.

As Boxing Day, 26th December 2009, falls on a Saturday, Government Offices will be closed on Monday, 28th December by virtue of Section 7A of the Public Holidays Act, 1947.

Note for the year 2010

As Christmas Day, 25th December 2010, falls on a Saturday, Government Offices will be closed on Monday, 27th December.

As Boxing Day, 26th December 2010, falls on a Sunday, by virtue of the Public Holidays Act, 1947 Tuesday, 28th December will be kept as a public holiday according to the Schedule to the Act.

Note for the year 2011

As New Year's Day, 1st January 2011, falls on a Saturday, Government Offices will be closed on Monday, 3rd January.

As Christmas Day, 25th December 2011, falls on a Sunday, by virtue of the Public Holidays Act, 1947 Tuesday, 27th December will be kept as a public holiday according to the Schedule to the Act.
